Kansas passes municipal suffrage

1912

Kansas passes state suffrage

1919

Missouri passes state suffrage
(presidential elections only)

June 4, 1919

19th Amendment passed by Congress
and sent to the states

June 16, 1919

Kansas ratifies 19th Amendment

July 3, 1919

Missouri ratifies 19th Amendment

August 18, 1920

Tennessee ratifies 19th Amendment,
ensuring its passage

August 26, 1920

U.S. Secretary of State Bainbridge Colby
certifies the ratification
