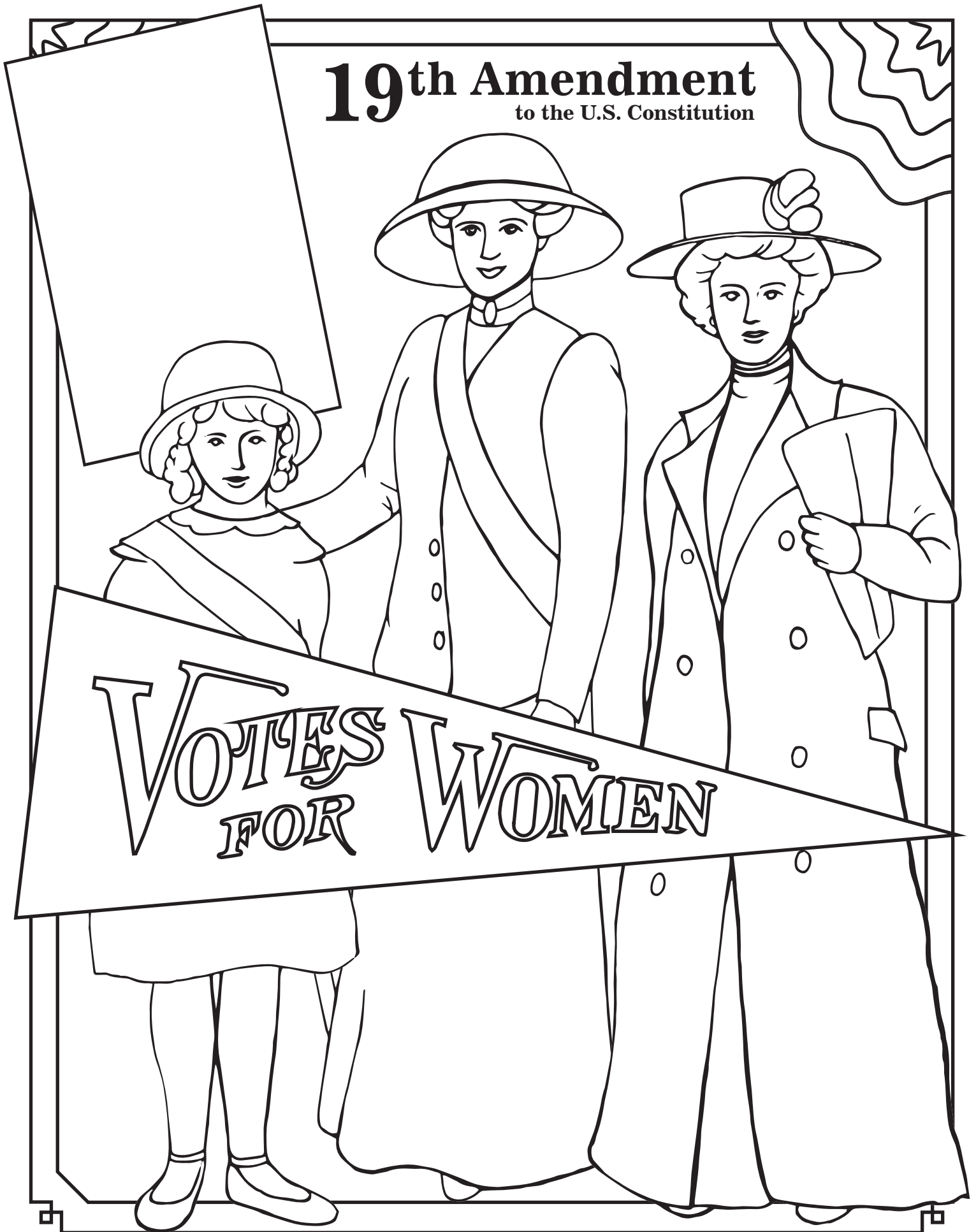

# TIMELINE

**July 1848**

Seneca Falls Convention, Declaration of Sentiments

**1887**

Kansas passes municipal suffrage

**1912**

Kansas passes state suffrage

**1919**

Missouri passes state suffrage  
(presidential elections only)

**June 4, 1919**

19<sup>th</sup> Amendment passed by Congress  
and sent to the states

**June 16, 1919**

Kansas ratifies 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment

**July 3, 1919**

Missouri ratifies 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment

**August 18, 1920**

Tennessee ratifies 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment,  
ensuring its passage

**August 26, 1920**

U.S. Secretary of State Bainbridge Colby  
certifies the ratification
